

Proposition 65 Certificate of Compliance

Venkel LTD. complies with California Proposition 65. All Venkel LTD. products meet the California Proposition 65 workplace and customer information requirements.

California Proposition 65 (also known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) refers to the California legislation that was intended by its authors to protect California citizens and the State's drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and to inform citizens about exposures to such chemicals.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide notice to Californians when there is potential exposure of significant amounts of certain chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment.

Based on a thorough internal review it has been determined that Venkel products do not contain any hazardous substances in Proposition 65 with the exception of some resistive products that contain small amounts of Lead (Pb) in the glass frit. However, this is allowed by RoHS 3 with the use of Exemption 7c-I and this substance does not come in contact with human skin and is not intended to be consumed in any way by humans. There is no risk of human exposure.

Therefore, Venkel LTD. products do not require California Proposition 65 warning labeling.
